END OF YEAR GOALS (NUMBER)...

• Reception (Early Learning Goal)

 Children count reliably with numbers from 1 to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Using quantities and objects, they add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. They solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

WHAT IS 'MATHS IS A HOOT'?

- A 'hands on', interactive way of teaching maths skills to young children.
- Sessions last 20 minutes and are taught every day.
- Children are taught in groups, at their own level.
- Games/activities sent home, based on what the children are learning in school.
