



School Dress

There is a school uniform which **all** children from reception to year 6 **are expected** to wear:

- Grey trousers or skirts
- White Polo shirts
- Royal blue gingham or striped dresses
- Royal blue sweat shirts or jumpers
- Children are also expected to wear plain black footwear, sensible shoes are preferred
- Socks/tights/hair accessories should be white or dark colours
- Only small book/P.E. kit bags

For PE children should wear a white T-shirt, dark shorts and plimsoles/trainers (for Foundation Stage and KS1 children no lace-ups please). Plain dark joggers are an optional extra. Each child will need a **labelled** bag to hold their PE kit. This may be kept in school except when it needs to be washed.

All items should be labelled with your child's name (especially; coats, plimsolls and jumpers or sweatshirts).

Children are allowed to wear **small stud earrings only**. This will be on the proviso that your child is able to remove the earrings themselves for P.E. This is a borough wide policy to comply with health and safety regulations. If your child is unable to remove and replace their own earrings, you will be contacted to come in and remove your child's earrings yourself. No nail varnish please.

Obviously, the school cannot be held responsible for the safekeeping of earrings, although the teacher will always remind the children to put their earrings in a safe place when they have to be taken out.
