LITERACY/Cognition and Learning Early Development

During this half term the ARP will be:

Describing themselves simply supported by selecting from options with symbols.

Learning family nouns and labelling pictures of families, e.g. Mum, Dad, brother, sister, aunty, uncle, grandma, little/big/baby brother and sister).

Write/trace/order names of self and family members. Answering and asking questions about families using photos as prompts.

Produce a book about our family with photos and captions e.g. This is my brother (support with colourful semantics, selecting captions with symbols, ordering prewritten words, dictating to an adult scribe etc).

- Introducing our phonics program of study called Little Wandle Phonics.
- Improving our reading skills by reading regularly at home and in school.
- Practising our letter formation.
- A large portion of our time will be spent focusing on phonics and reading this term. Children will have a dedicated time throughout the day to practice specific reading skills as well as daily D.E.A.R. time.
