- Identifying characteristics of the four countries

#### **MATHS**

This half term we will be:

- Recognising common 2D and 3D shapes presented in different orientations, and knowing that rectangles, triangles, cuboids, and pyramids are not always similar to one another.
- Composing numbers to 10 from 2 parts, and partition numbers to 10 into parts.
- Recognising where a number lies on a number line.
- Recognising and understanding what odd and even numbers are.
- Finding a missing number using a part whole model.

#### SCIENCE

During this half term we will be:

- Observe changes across the four seasons.
- Observe and describe weather associated with the seasons.
- Understand the day length is affected by seasons.
- Understand how animals and humans are affected by the seasons.
- Asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways.
- Gathering and recording data to help in answering questions.
