

Year 2 Homework Menu: Spring Term 1, 2025 – What is in our Natural World?

Every day:

- 5 10 minutes Spelling

Literacy

Choose one of your favourite book characters and write a description about their appearance and behaviour, include expanded noun phrases to make your writing more interesting.

Art

Create an image of your favourite book character using any materials you have at home such as pencils, crayons, paint, or even recycled materials to make a collage. You could extend your artwork by adding a background for your character such as where the character lives or a scene from the story.

Science

Try doing 4 different exercises for 3 minutes each exercise (*jumping, skipping, hopping, jogging, dribbling a ball, dancing – there are lots more to choose from*) Which exercise did you enjoy most and why?
