- Large manor house in Hay on Wye, Wales
- Owned and run by LBBD
- Staffed by fully qualified, trained teachers (unlike other outdoor centres)
- Local river (River Wye) and caves (Porth yr Ogof) and waterfalls used for activities

# Dates and Numbers
