COMMUNICATION, LANGUAGE & LITERACY

Mark Making Books this half term:

Lionel Lines, Archie Rainbow, Making marks with Swirlo and Monster Marks with Ziggy.

To be able to tell the difference between different sounds e.g. in the environment, when using musical instruments and in familiar rhymes such as Humpty Dumpty, Twinkle Twinkle.

To listen in a group for short periods of time.

Talk to adults and peers in simple sentences.

Writing: To experiment and talk about making meaningful marks such as drawing and painting simple patterns, shapes and pictures.

Reading: To identify their own name to self-register.

To have favourite songs and rhymes.
Share and listen with interest to books and stories.

MATHEMATICS

To sort a range of objects (toys, fruit, counters) into sets in different ways e.g. by colour, shape and size.

To understand and use the terms 'in', 'on', 'under' and 'over', in correct contexts.

To sing/say number names (in order) to 5 and

then 10 in songs, rhymes and play.

To use counting in games and when playing e.g. 1 car, 2 cars etc.

Be able to look at sharing and say who has more, less or the same.

We will send you a reminder about when the children need to start bringing in their PE kits.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Learn how to operate simple technology in the Nursery such as a computer mouse, push button doors.

Understand and follow simple Nursery rules and routines showing care and concern.

Talk about special times or events for family or friends such as parties, days out and celebrations including a developing awareness of festivals – this term is Harvest.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

Move in and around obstacles carefully.
Travel up and down steps safely.

Manage washing and drying own hands and attend to own toilet needs.

Tell adults about their needs e.g. when hungry, tired or upset.

Use one handed tools and equipment to draw lines and circles with control.

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

To separate from main carers without support and show confidence towards unfamiliar people and new social situations.

Demonstrate friendly behaviour, initiating conversations & play and by forming good relationships with peers & familiar adults.

To share, take turns and co-operate with others.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS & DESIGN

Join in with simple songs, rhymes and ring games.
Engage in imaginative play e.g. playing 'house', mimicking adults, being the 'voices' to toy animals/people/vehicles.

Explore mixing colours in different ways and understand that lines can be used to create enclosed spaces such as shapes, faces or other familiar objects.

Explore building e.g. towers, walls, enclosures.

Reminders:

- Unfortunately, due to the current situation adults will not be permitted to enter the Nursery with their children.
- Please **do not** send your children with unnecessary items to Nursery, such as rucksacks, lunch boxes, etc.
- Please clearly label all your children's clothes, including shoes and socks/tights as they will be removing these for PE sessions.
