Dear Parent/Carer,

Stubbers Adventure Centre -Bonham Road site

The day trip to Stubbers Adventure Centre is fast approaching, and the children are getting very excited. We will be taking the year group as a whole so as to avoid crossing 'bubbles', on Thursday, 1st July 2021. We will be travelling by coach.

Children will need to be in school for 8:15 am sharp, we will not wait for late comers! We aim to be back to school for approximately 5:30 pm depending on traffic. The children will be doing three activities, two 'dry' activities and one 'wet' activity. Please be assured that for 'wet' activities, the children will be wearing buoyancy aids and do not need to be able to swim to participate.

The children need to take a bag containing;

A packed lunch, bottle of water (plastic bottle only), snacks if require - polite reminder NO NUTS or CHEWING GUM

- Water bottles can be topped up at Stubbers.
- A change of clothes in case they are too wet to wear the same clothes for the next activity. Stubbers suggest 2 tops (at least 1 to be long sleeved) and 2 bottoms (at least 1 to be full length). A jumper/fleece in case they get cold.
- A change of shoes in case they get them too wet for the next activity.
- A towel to help them dry off.
- Sun cream if needed

These would be best taken in a sports bag rather than a carrier bag as they break easily. A bin bag inside could hold any wet clothes that they are bringing home. Clothes should be labelled with names. The children can wear any clothes that day (old ones are best), jogging bottoms/leggings only. They need to be wearing trainer style shoes – not flip-flops or any type of open shoe e.g. sandals. The instructors will not allow them to take part if they are wearing incorrect footwear. They should also wear a jacket.

The children are not allowed to take any valuables/mobile phones/I-Pads or money.
