


Our topic is: Truly Scrumptious W/C: 11th January 2021

| | <p>Goldilocks and the three Bears</p>  | <p>What I need...</p> <p>Here is the story:</p> <p>Goldilocks and the Three Bears by Oxbridge Baby - YouTube</p> | <p>Intended outcome...</p> |

| <p>Activity 1</p> | <p>Painting /drawing Children to paint or draw a picture of The Three Bears house. Model painting/drawing a square and a triangle for outline of house. Encourage your child to add detail to their picture. Talk about the shapes they have drawn/painted.</p> | | <p>I can draw/paint a house</p> |
| <p>Activity 2</p> | <p>Bear Size Ordering Show your child the three bears (see activity 2). Cut these out or ask your child to. Can your child put them in size order – smallest to biggest? Ask your child to draw 3 bowls – small, medium and large, for each bear. This can be extended to drawing the chairs and the beds.</p> | | <p>I can order objects by size</p> |
| <p>Activity 3</p> | <p>Doing the right thing If you have a copy, read the story to your child. As you read talk about Goldilocks behaviour. Did she do the right thing? Should she have gone into the Bears house/eat the porridge/break the chair etc. Encourage your child to respond in full sentences.</p> | | <p>I can talk about behaviour and identify what is right and what is wrong.</p> |
